## PE Kit

We have returned to having PE sessions, gymnastics and dance, in the hall. Please could you ensure that your child has the appropriate indoor PE kit of t-shirt and shorts. Leggings / jogging bottoms and an extra top should still be kept in their PE bag to use on days when children do outdoor PE. Could parents of younger children be aware that tights should be removed for PE.

## Rucksacks

During a recent fire inspection, the fire officer commented on the amount of large bags that are causing an obstruction in our corridor cloakrooms. Whilst I am loathed to stop the children bringing in their rucksacks, I must agree with the Fire officer's comments; they are causing a problem which could be deemed as dangerous. Please could I ask you to ascertain whether your child needs a large rucksack/bag each day and if not encourage them to use something smaller.

## Changes to the self-isolation period

From Monday 17 January, people (children) who are self-isolating with COVID-19 will have the option to reduce their isolation period after 5 full days if they test negative with a lateral flow device (LFD) test on both day 5 and day 6 and they do not have a temperature. For example, if they test negative on the morning of day 5 and the morning of day 6, they can return to school immediately on day 6.

The first test must be taken no earlier than day 5 of the self-isolation period, and the second must be taken the following day. All test results should be [reported to NHS Test and Trace](#).

If the result of either of their tests is positive, they should continue to self-isolate until they get negative results from two LFD tests on consecutive days or until they have completed 10 full days of self-isolation, whichever is earliest.
