## TT Rock Stars

In June, our Year 4 children will need to complete the DfE's multiplication tables check. This is a timed test (6 seconds per question) of your child's fluency in the recall of multiplication tables up to 12. Knowing the multiplication tables is essential for future success in maths and an essential life skill which is why we pay to subscribe to Times Tables Rock Stars for every child in Year 2. Currently, only 6 children across the school (yrs2 -6) know all the multiplication table up to 12x12 so please support us by encouraging your child to use this programme every day. Let's see if we can double that number each month - if we do, every child should know the multiplication table facts by June!
