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Behaviour

This half term we are having a particular focus on low-level behavior and the impact this has on children's learning. We have introduced Zones of Regulation to support the children with managing their feelings and emotions and we have placed higher importance on our learning skills to help the children focus on how to be good learners. Ultimately, we want all our children to be intrinsically motivated to do the right thing all the time but occasionally children, like adults, need to be rewarded too. We are asking our children to be responsible for their behaviour and may, on occasion, this half term, acknowledge and reward them for doing so. Conversely we will be applying appropriate sanctions such as missed break times for behavior that is unacceptable. We will keep you informed of any incident that requires a sanction and hope you will support us in ensuring that the behaviour in this school remains outstanding.
