We will investigate and interpret the past. Through role play we will experience some aspects of Ancient Roman life and communicate our thoughts and opinions creatively. At the end we will reenact a Roman battle, and hopefully live to tell the tale through the eyes of either a Ruthless Roman Soldier or Terrified British Citizen!

Steps to success:

STEP 6 - Roman Battle - Experiencing a Roman battle

STEP 7 - Write up! Writing from the perspective of a ruthless Roman soldier or a terrified British civilian.
