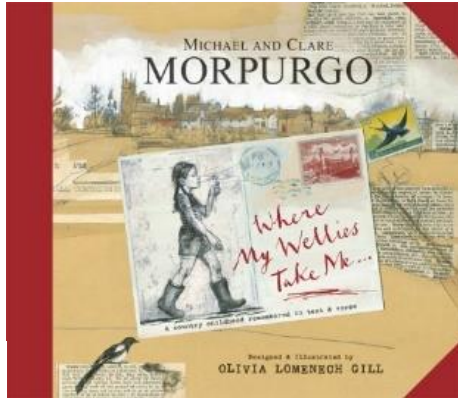


Where My Wellies Take Me.



Big Picture

A four-week learning experience where we will become Geographers! We will be learning about where we are in the world, and going out into the field to observe, sketch and identify what makes Bosham unique. We will also use collage and watercolours to create a page of the book all about Bosham.

Steps to Success:

HOOK: Read book, 'Where my wellies take me' by Clare and Michael Morpurgo

Geography Step 1: Zooming in - Where in the WORLD is Bosham? We will look at continents of the world and how to identify them.

Step 2: Zooming in - the UK: Using Ordnance Survey maps and a compass to find Bosham on a map.

Step 3: Zooming in - Bosham What are the physical features of our village?

Step 4: Exploring Bosham - immersing ourselves in the OS map symbols

Step 5: Walk around Bosham- using our new knowledge and expertise to take a walk around the village.

Step 6: Nature artists- can we each prepare a page much like our book, all about Bosham?

English Step 1: Poetry immersion - what makes a good poem?

Step 2 - what is 'personification'? and what is a 'synonym'?

Step 2: Poetry writing- Vocabulary collecting!

Step 3: Becoming published poets.

Art Step 1: What is a collage?

Step 2: What effect does watercolour have?

Step 3: Create a page for our class book using watercolours and collage.

As well as all this we will be reading and responding to *Nim's Island* and *Where My Wellies Take Me*.
