Due to headteacher interviews taking place next week, we are unable to host rock steady that day as the hall will be used during the interview process.



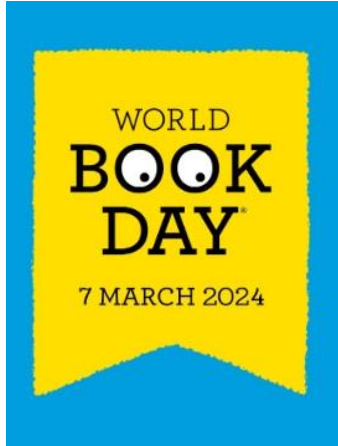
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World Book Day 2024 - Thursday 7th March
